### About the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE)

The OSCE adopts a comprehensive approach to security that encompasses politico-military, economic, environmental and human dimensions. Therefore, the organization addresses a wide range of security-related problems, including arms control, confidence- and security-building measures, human rights, national minorities, democratization, police strategies, counter-terrorism, as well as economic and environmental activities. All 57 participating states have equal status, and decisions are taken by consensus on a political but not legally binding basis.

### A joint international technical assistance project implemented by the CEC and the OSCE:

#### **Strengthening cybersecurity and transparency of electoral processes in Ukraine 2017-2022**

The main achievements of the Project are:

- equipping the CEC with many cybersecurity tools, including hardware and software;
- over 700 hours of training for CEC representatives;
- offline programs, chat bots and electronic systems were developed;
- the CEC's official website was modernized;
- procurement of software for the CEC's electronic document management system and personnel management system was ensured.
